COMPOSITION:

Each ml contains:

Cefaguinome Sulphate equivalent to Cefaquinome 25mg

INDICATIONS:

For the treatment of bacterial infections of respiratory system, foot infection, mastitis in cattle caused by the gram positive and gramnegative microorganism sensitive to Cefaguinome. It is also effective in E. coli infections in calves

PHARMACOLOGICAL PROPERTIES

Cefaquinome sulfate is an antibiotic that belongs to the group of cephalosporin of IV generation. It inhibits the synthesis of the microbial cell wall. Bactericidal against grampositive and gram-negative microorganisms (E. coli, Citrobacter spp., Klebsiella spp., Proteus spp., Salmonella spp., Bacillus spp., Corynebacterium spp., Staphylococcus spp., Streptococcus spp., Bactericides spp., Clostridium spp., Fusobacterium spp., Prevotella spp., Actinobacillus spp., Pasteurella multocida, Mannheimia haemolytica, Serratia marcescens, Haemophilus somnus, Arcanobacterium pyogenic, and Erysipelotrix rhusiopathiae).

DOSAGE & ADMINISTRATION:

Cattle / Buffalo: 2ml per 50kg bodyweight intramuscularly for 3 to 5 days.

Calves: 4ml per 50kg bodyweight intramuscularly for 3 to 5 days.

Horse: 2ml per 50kg body weight intramuscularly for 3 to 5 days.

CONTRA-INDICATIONS:

Do not use in animals, which are known to be hypersensitive to ß-lactam antibiotics.

Do not administer to animals less than 1.25 kg body weight.

Do not use in poultry (including eggs) due to risk of spread of antimicrobial resistance to humans

WITHDRAWALTIME:

Meat: 5 days. Milk: 1 days.

PRECUATIONS:

Consult the veterinarian before use. Keep out of the reach of children. Store between 15-25°C in a cool and dry place.
